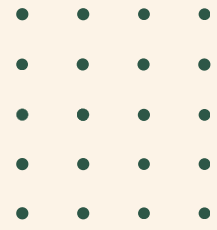

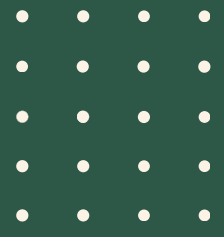

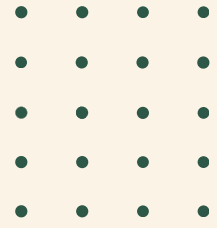


Vision: To demonstrate the love of Christ in the service and care of destitute children.

OVERALL IMPACT AT A GLANCE

- **2,124 children** supported through residential care
- **408 children** nurtured in daycare centres
- **761 individuals** reached through Kiruba centres
- **633 students** enrolled in CMS schools
- **142 young adults** supported through aftercare education
- **67 individuals** trained through vocational centres
- **60 individuals** reached through community initiatives

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Education and Health Support Initiative, supported by AVT, has played a vital role in strengthening access to quality education and holistic development for children in Child Care Institutions (CCIs).

Over the past ten months, key interventions included:

- 1. Life Skills Education Training for CCI facilitators**
- 2. Ongoing online academic support for Grades 9, 10, and 12**
- 3. Infrastructure support through provision of desks and benches in Aurangabad**

These initiatives have contributed significantly to both academic progress and personal development among children.

1. LIFE SKILLS EDUCATION

Vision

To ensure that every child in CCIs is equipped with essential life skills to lead a confident, healthy, and purposeful life.

Programme Overview

CMS initiated the Life Skills Champions Programme to promote holistic child development, guided by the World Health Organisation's 10 Life Skills and UNICEF's Life Skills Framework.

The programme focuses on nurturing:

- **Cognitive Skills** – *critical thinking and decision-making*
- **Emotional Skills** – *self-awareness, resilience, and empathy*
- **Social Skills** – *communication, teamwork, and respect*

Implementation Highlights

- Training Dates: February 8–10, 2026
- Participants: 20 trainers from 5 states representing 26 CCIs
- Modules Introduced:
 - a. *“Unique Me & Empowered We” (Ages 6–12)*
 - b. *“Spark Within” (Ages 13–18)*



LIFE SKILLS EDUCATION (CONT..)

Key Achievements

- Development of age-appropriate life skills curriculum
- Successful 3-day Training of Trainers (ToT)
- Establishment of a mentoring and cascade model
- Creation of a safe and participatory learning environment

Transformational Impact

The programme has resulted in:

- *Deep personal transformation among trainers*
- *Improved communication and empathetic engagement skills*
- *Strengthened focus on dignity, equality, and child protection*
- *Increased motivation to serve as change-makers*

The symbolic “candle pledge” reinforced participants’ commitment to shaping children’s futures.



LIFE SKILLS EDUCATION (CONT..)

Scale of Impact

- *26 Child Care Institutions engaged*
- *20 trained facilitators*
- *1,000+ children to benefit directly*

Sustainability

- Trainers are actively cascading the programme to children and caregivers
- Two modules per month will be implemented through 2026–27
- The programme ensures long-term behavioural and developmental outcomes



2. ACADEMIC SUPPORT – ONLINE CLASSES

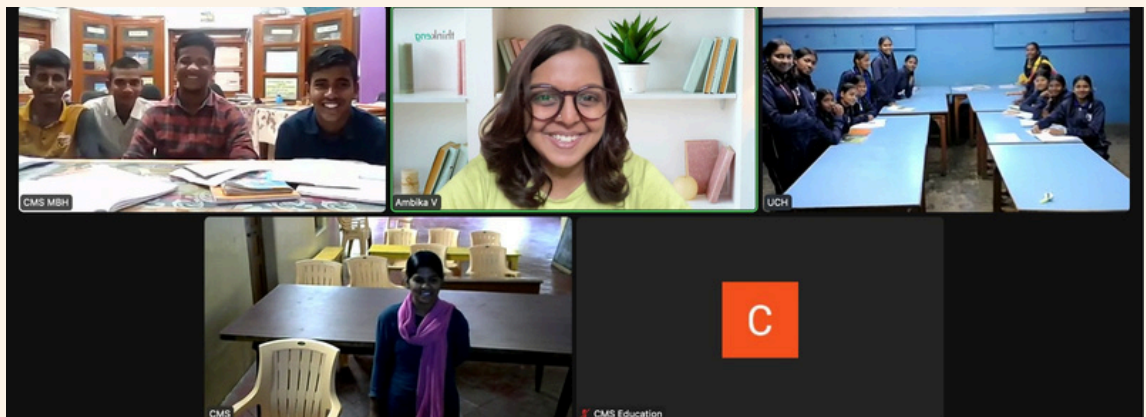
With the support of AVT, CMS provided structured online academic coaching for students in Grades 9, 10, and 12.

Impact

- **186 students** attended Grade 9 Mathematics
- **90 students** attended Grade 12 Mathematics
- **174 students** attended Grade 10 English
- **90 students** attended Grade 12 English

Across **17 Child Care Institutions**, students benefited from consistent academic guidance, strengthening their confidence and performance in key subjects.

This initiative has been instrumental in bridging learning gaps and supporting children toward academic success.

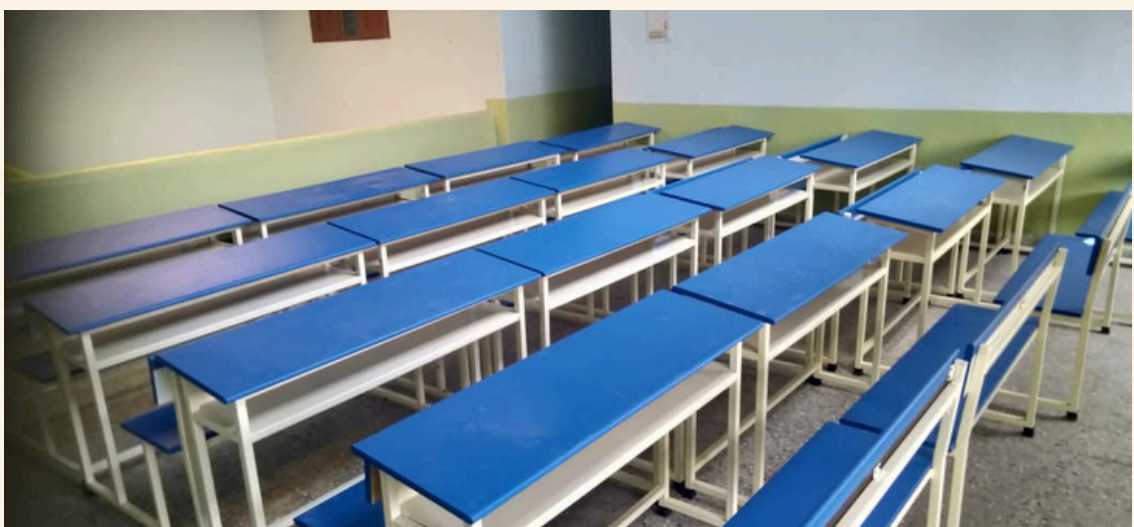


3. INFRASTRUCTURE SUPPORT – AURANGABAD UNIT

We are deeply thankful to AVT for supporting the **revival of the Aurangabad centre.**

- The centre is being re-established as an **evening tuition programme**
- **120 vulnerable children** from nearby government schools will benefit
- **40 benches and desks** have been provided to ensure a conducive learning environment

This initiative marks a significant step in expanding CMS's outreach to underserved communities.

My name is S/Devi, and I am a student studying in Class 10 at one of the Child Care Institutions supported by CMS. I would like to thank you from the bottom of my heart for the support AVT has given to us through online classes.

Before joining these classes and activities, I used to feel very nervous about my studies, especially Mathematics and English. I was afraid to ask questions, and sometimes I thought I was not capable of doing well in school. But things started changing slowly because of the opportunities AVT and CMS provided us.

The online classes helped me understand my subjects better. The teachers explained concepts patiently, and I was able to clear many doubts that I had for a long time. Now, I feel more confident while writing exams, and I believe I can achieve good marks.

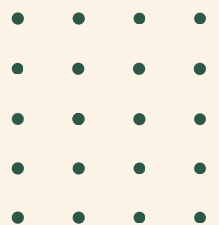

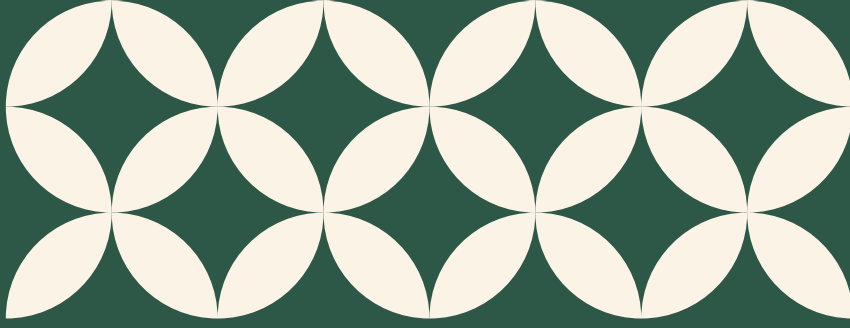

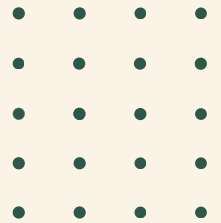
